



Directions

From Interstate 40 take exit 123, 321 North to Lenoir. At the intersection of Highway 321 and 18/64/90 continue traveling on 321 North for 2.1 miles. Turn left onto N. Main Street and go 2.6 miles. Turn right onto Abington Road and go 8 miles. At stop sign, turn left onto HWY 90 and go 1.0 mile. Turn left onto Adako Road. Park is on left (0.2 miles.)
