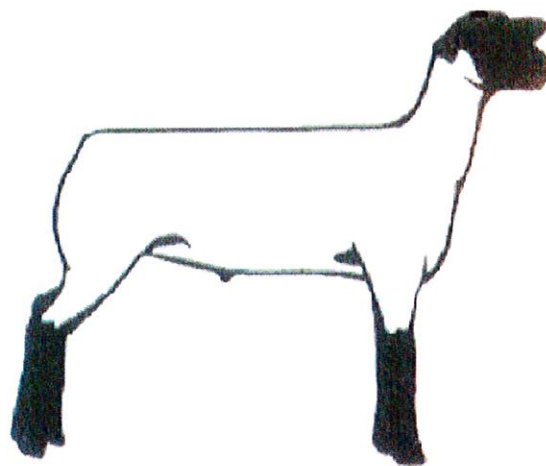
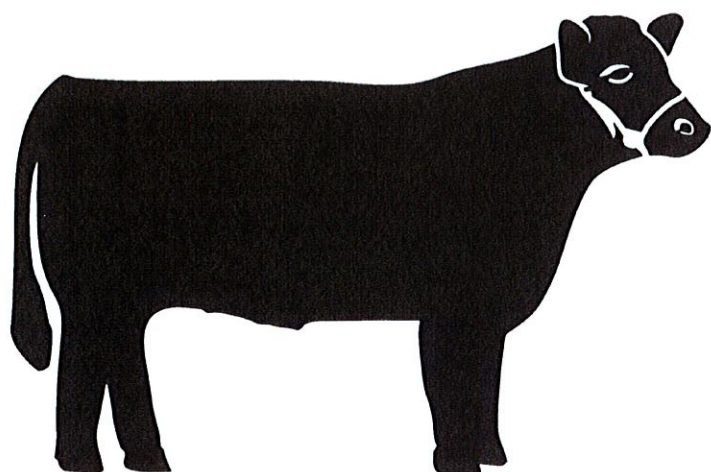

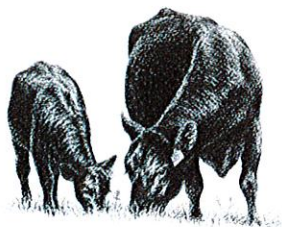

**Circuit Show Rules**

1. Show open to youth ages 5-18. Youth showmanship classes are based on the child's age as of January 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. The barn will open at 7:30 a.m. and check-in will begin at 8:00 a.m. The show will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.
3. Registration deadline is **5:00 pm, Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**. All entries must be made on an official entry form and submitted with entry fee(s). Make checks payable to: **Burke County 4-H**.
4. Exhibitors must have trained and fitted their animals. Registration papers for livestock are not required.
5. There will be a \$5 Entry fee for each class entered. All fees must be submitted with registration forms.
6. All animals must be healthy and will be inspected upon entering the barn area. All sheep and goats must display Scrapie tags.
7. Parents are encouraged to assist exhibitors with their animals but parents and other adults will not be allowed to handle entries in the ring.
8. Exhibitors who have more than one entry per class must have another eligible exhibitor show their other animal.
9. All classes of eight or more entries may be divided. Any class may be divided at the discretion of the show judge or Burke County Extension staff.
10. All lambs & wethers in the Market class must be shown with less than ¼ inch fleece. Market Animals will be weighed at check-in and classes may be divided by weight.
11. All exhibits must be washed and clean to be judged.
12. All exhibitors must wear their exhibitor cards in the show ring.
13. Spectators and exhibitors assume all liabilities for themselves, their livestock and belongings. No dogs allowed in the barn area.

These showmanship classes will be part of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship Circuit.
