As we get back on track, it will be expected that youth desiring to compete in upcoming 4-H events will need to participate in either the 4-H Project Record Book (PRB) and/or the 4-H Presentations contests. The Project Record Book should reflect your activities from all of 2022. The Presentation season is approaching and I am glad to help you pick a topic and design a presentation. During this upcoming presentation season, we will also be hosting a County 4-H Talent Show. These winners will move to our District Talent competition in June (West District Activity Day). Participants submitting an Electric Project Book may be eligible to win a Free 2 night trip to 4-H Electric Congress in July. Teens (I2-I8) that participate in the PRB or Presentation categories are eligible to attend the week-long State 4-H Congress in Raleigh, July 22-25.




