Agriculture

- 22 beef producers participated in a bulk mineral purchasing program saving them over \$5 per bag.
- As a result of the Summer Annuals Workshop, 7 producers planted summer annual forage to supplement their hay production and ended the season with a feed surplus.

Family & Consumer Sciences

- 56 adults indicated they are consuming less added sugar due to education received from Extension.
- 68 Burke County senior citizens received 21st Century technology skills with hands-on training.

4-H Youth Development

- 34 youth from across the state participated in the Binding Memories t-shirt quilt workshop offered both in person and virtually.
- 1,032 Burke County youth participated in camps, workshops and school enrichment opportunities.

Horticulture

- 19 Burke County citizens completed the Extension Master Gardener class and became volunteers for the horticulture program.
- 800 nursery and landscape professionals were educated about Japanese Maple scale and how to control it.

Community Resource Development

- 54 Extension professionals attended Facilitation Training statewide and a 3-day Facilitation Certification Training was offered with 43 individuals across NC becoming certified.
- A grant of \$45,000 was secured to offer the Empowering Youth and Families Program (an opioid prevention program) to Burke County Families.
